

# What is the role of... The Complex Care Team?

The Complex Care Team are based within the surgery providing support to patients in the community by visiting them at home.

If a patient is too unwell or classified as housebound, the complex care team are able to go out and visit the patient in their own home. This ensures the patient can continue to receive any necessary treatment.

They provide support to elderly patients who need further healthcare and can do continuing healthcare assessments to ensure patients receive the help and care they need.

They can prescribe medication.

They can care, support and assess patients by doing similar things to the ANPs. For example, doing wound swabs, bloods and assessing for infections etc.

They provide regular reviews and follow ups for patients.

They work alongside the GPs and the Nurses based at the surgery.
